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#### **School Day**

The school day is simplified to an **8:45 start** and a **3:15 finish** for all classes. The gates will be opened at 8:35 – please ensure that your child is in school **by** 8:45 for registration.

#### **Jewellery**

A reminder that children should not be wearing any jewellery to school apart from studded earrings. This is for safety reasons as well as protection against precious items being lost or damaged.

#### Uniform

A reminder that we ask for your child to wear a school sweatshirt, cardigan or hoodie as part of our required uniform. These can be purchased from Key Wear in Truro. The rest of the uniform can be purchased anywhere you wish. This decision is in place to ensure that the cost of uniform is kept low.
