Personal, Social and Emotional Development

In our SCARF work the children will be learning about Growing and Changing. They will be learning the different stages in childhood and growing up. They will read stories to help them understand where babies come from e.g. 'There's a house inside my Mummy'. They will also learn the correct vocabulary when naming the different parts of the body.

Physical Development

Mathematics

We will be manipulating, composing and decomposing 2-d and 3-d shapes.

Understanding sharing and grouping.

Visualising and creating patterns and creating and exploring own pattern rules as well as replicating and building scenes and constructions.

Understanding the World

Children will be identifying where Cornwall is on a Map as well as naming other towns and villages around the county.

They will be learning about famous landmarks around Cornwall, such as Pendennis Castle, St Michaels Mount and Lands End.

They will also be finding out some historical facts about mining and some similarities and differences between the sea side in the present and past.

In their Science work, the children will be looking at the beach environment and how to protect it.

Expressive Arts and Design

Through our Art work the children will be making and painting their own Lighthouses, and Sunset pictures as well as sand art, exploring textures and transient art using loose parts such as shells and pebbles..

They will also be looking at the artist Paul Klee and creating their own boat pictures using shapes.

The children will have the opportunity to make their own Seaside Puppet plays 'That's the way to do it!' and perform them to an audience!

They will continue to sing and play instruments in our Music time.

What you need to know...

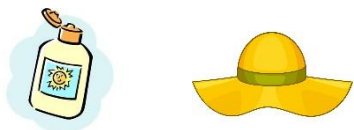
Reading Books
